PPE Supply for Community-Based Practices

As noted in the May 22 NLMA Update, the Department of Health and Community Services will provide private physician clinics with PPE beyond the 3 PPE emergency kits that were previously made available.

The following PPE will be available beginning Wednesday, May 27:

- Face shields
• EN standard surgical masks (pending delivery)
• Procedural masks for patients
• Members can continue to replenish the three emergency kits containing gowns, gloves, surgical masks, patient procedural masks and goggles or face shields.

PPE will be available for pick-up once per week as supplies allow. Quantities for clinics are based on the order form that clinics provided to the NLMA on May 14th.

Pick-up locations are outlined the contact list below. To control the flow of people in and out of hospitals pick-up will be available on Wednesdays only.

Please call ahead to ensure that your order will be ready for you upon arrival.

A confirmation email from noreply@formstack.com was sent to the contact person for your practice following submission of the order form/PPE estimate for your clinic. This confirmation email contains a copy of your PPE order request. Please note that the gowns and gloves included on the NLMA order form are currently not available from the RHA inventory for community practices.
