UPDATE - PPE Supply for Community-Based Practices

The Department of Health has advised the NLMA that the PPE available for pick-up tomorrow for private community-based practices will include face shields and unrated masks; however, it will not include the EN surgical masks. The shipment of EN surgical masks that was expected today is currently stuck in customs. Members will be advised when these masks arrive and are made available.

The following PPE will be available beginning Wednesday, May 27:

- Face shields
• Procedural masks

Members can also continue to replenish the three emergency kits containing gowns, gloves, surgical masks, patient procedural masks and goggles or face shields.

As noted above, a shipment of EN standard surgical masks is enroute and will be made available when delivered.
