Update: Delayed Payments Under the Pandemic Work Disruption Policy

Late last week, the NLMA learned that the first additional services top-up to 100%, which was to have been paid by MCP on the September 9, 2020 pay date, did not occur.

This affects those FFS physicians who provided additional services within the March 18 to April 29 period.

The logistics associated with calculating the additional services top-up for distinct time periods, on a daily basis, for over 500 FFS physicians registered under the Policy has proven to be challenging; however, we have engaged the Department and this is being addressed in earnest. **A detailed Newsletter from MCP will be released in the coming days.**
